- Must check in with Bridget 30 minutes before the shift. Check out with the volunteer coordinator/Bridget at the end of the shift.
- Volunteer coordinator/Bridget can sign off on volunteer hours at the end of your shift when you check out.
- If you want to enjoy the event before your shift, check in with the volunteer coordinator/Bridget the morning of your shift. They will give you your pass for the day.

SET UP: Merchants may begin setting up on Friday Oct 22nd and/or Saturday Oct 23rd and Oct 24th 7am to 9:45 am before the event. Gate opens at 10 am, all vehicles must be away from the Entertainment area and in the designated merchant/vendor/volunteer area by 9:45 am Saturday and Sunday.

Rules, Guidelines & Terms:

- 1) **Period of event:** This event (**MacDudley's Market Faire**) will focus on the period of 1300-1901. Emphasis on 1860-1901. Halloween garb and décor encouraged. This is a garb event. (Please be in period costume or a Halloween costume) Please dress in appropriate costume. No nudity permitted, have all tops secured properly to avoid wardrobe malfunctions. This is a family friendly event.
- 2) **Masks:** Follow current local, state, and federal guidelines at time of event.
- 3) **Alcohol:** Alcohol is not permitted on festival grounds at any time.
- 4) **Smoking:** Local laws do not allow smoking in the park.
- 5) **Parking:** Volunteers will need to park with the vendors/merchants or in the public parking section. No vehicles can be parked in the arena.
- 6) **Spiritualism/Religion:** We at MacDudley Dragon Entertainment LLC respects and honors all religious and spiritual beliefs. MacDudley Dragon Entertainment LLC will not tolerate religious discrimination of any kind.
- 7) **Politics:** To keep things light-hearted, volunteers, merchants, and merchandise promoting political agendas are not allowed.
- 8) **Children:** All children 16 and under ALWAYS need to be accompanied by an adult, no exceptions.
- 9) **Clean-up:** Volunteers may be assigned or asked to assist with booth tear down Sunday evening. Merchants are required to keep the area in and around their booth clean and free of trash. Trash cans will be provided in and around the arena.
- 10) **Family Friendly:** This is a family event during 10 am to 6 pm. Wardrobe and speech should be rated "G", for all audiences. Our audience will also consist of people with different disabilities so please be a little more understanding with them.
- 11) **Stay in Character:** At any time when you are interacting with guests, try to stay in character with the theme of the event. Your voice and dress should help immerse attendees in the event.
- 12) **Security:** Security is on site during event hours; however, volunteers are solely responsible for their own personal belongings.
- 13) **Marketing:** All submitted pictures and those taken at the event by MacDudley Dragon Entertainment LLC staff become the property of MacDudley Dragon Entertainment LLC and may be used for marketing purposes.

- 14) **Animals:** Only service animals for the disabled are allowed. Animals that are part of a performance or demonstration are allowed with pre-approval. Vaccination history is required.

Terms: Each party agrees to indemnify and hold the other party harmless from all damages, judgments, awards, settlements and other liabilities (including, without limitation, attorneys' fees and expenses in defense of the same) resulting from any claims, proceedings, suits or actions brought against the other party which arise out of or relate to such party's actions or omissions in performing services. Neither party shall be liable to the other party for any lost profits or other indirect or consequential damages.

MacDudley Dragon Entertainment LLC shall not be liable for its failure to perform any term or condition under this Agreement, or for any indirect or special damages or loss which may be suffered by a vendor in connection with such failure to perform, if said failure to perform or damages are a result of conditions beyond Entertaining History's control such as, but not limited to, war, insurrection, strikes, fires, floods, acts of God, governmental restrictions, power failures, or any other cause beyond the reasonable control of Entertaining History, Inc.

This Application and Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and shall be governed by and construed according to the laws of the State of Michigan.
